To Whom It May Concern:

I represent a group of authors who have each had a PhD thesis illegally published through your company. In the attachment A, you will find a list of the theses and the respective books. We have confirmed that the ISBN numbers are associated to you. You are the publisher of the books since you copy and distribute the books.

Publishing these theses has caused considerable loss to the authors. This includes:

1. Unauthorised publication: the authors were never in contact with you and did not intend to publish their thesis through you.
2. Breach of copyright: Copying the original work in these theses is a breach of copyright law, as is issuing such copies to the public.
3. Damage to reputation: the theses have been modified and the books misrepresent the work of the authors. Moreover, self-publishing a thesis in academia is not well-regarded, damages the reputation of the authors, and is also a derogatory treatment in breach of copyright moral rights.
4. Lost income: some of the authors intend to publish their thesis and prior publication by you prevents them from earning such income.
5. Emotional distress: the authors experienced considerable distress by having their work exposed on major book-selling platforms such as Amazon, and having to deal with the theft of their work.
6. Time and effort: the authors have had to expend considerable time and effort identifying your company, coordinating our concerns and work on presenting them to you.

Based on these losses, we ask you to act within one week of receiving this letter to:

1. Reveal the full contact details of the people who illegally publish the theses through you. As privacy and confidentiality cannot be used to protect wrongdoing, you are legally obliged to disclose this information. If you do not disclose this information, we will be forced to assume your company is solely responsible for the wrongful publication of these works.
2. Remove the theses from your system and prevent any further distribution.

3. Agree to pay 500 USD compensation to each of the authors for the losses outlined above.
4. Issue an apology for the unlawful practices within your business.
5. Undertake plausible steps to prevent any reoccurrence of this situation. This includes you checking your current offerings for other cases of theft.
6. Report the prevention steps back to the authors.

Please note that Brendan Ritchie has already contacted you directly and that you partially complied with his request. In attachment B, you find a second list of books that I have good reason to believe are also stolen PhD thesis, but I have not confirmed this with the respective authors.
